 been based upon the oldest MS. of Vitruvius, the Harleian 2767 of the British Museum, probably of  
 the eighth century, and from the Saxon scriptorium of Northumbria in which the Codex Amiatinus  
 was written. The Latin closely resembles that of the workshop and the street. In my translation I  
 have sought to retain the vividness and accuracy of the original, and have not sought a smoothness of  
 rendering which would become a more polished style. The reader, it is possible, may discern the  
 genial figure of Vitruvius through his utterances. In a technical treatise the risks of the translator  
 are many. The help of Dr. House has rendered them less formidable, but he is not responsible for the  
 errors which have survived revision. The introduction has been limited to such considerations as  
 may enable the layman to enter into the mysteries of the craft, and the general reader to follow the  
 stages by which the successive accretions to the text have been removed. The section upon language  
 indicates some of the relations of Vitruvius to Old Latin generally. My examination of fourteen MSS.

 THE WEST THE history of architectural literature is taken by Vitruvius to begin with the theatre of  
 Dionysus at Athens. 1 In earlier times the spectators were accommodated upon wooden benches.  
 According to one account, 2 in the year 500 B. C. or thereabouts, the scaffolding collapsed, and in  
 consequence a beginning was made towards a permanent stone structure. The elaborate stage  
 settings of Aeschylus reached their culmination at the performance of the Agamemnon and its  
 associated plays in 458. According to Suidas, 3 the collapse of the scaffolding, which occurred at a  
 performance of one of Aeschylus dramas, led to the exile of the poet in Sicily, where he died in 456.  
 In that case the permanent construction of the theatre would begin in the Periclean age some time  
 between 458 and 456...

**Heathen** Kathryn Gin Lum.2022-05-17 An innovative history that shows how the religious idea of the heathen in need of salvation undergirds American conceptions of race. If an eighteenth-century parson told you that the difference between “civilization and heathenism is sky-high and star-far,” the words would hardly come as a shock. But that statement was written by an American missionary in 1971. In a sweeping historical narrative, Kathryn Gin Lum shows how the idea of the heathen has been maintained from the colonial era to the present in religious and secular discourses—discourses, specifically, of race. Americans long viewed the world as a realm of suffering heathens whose lands and lives needed their intervention to flourish. The term “heathen” fell out of common use by the early 1900s, leading some to imagine that racial categories had replaced religious differences. But the ideas underlying the figure of the heathen did not disappear. Americans still treat large swaths of the world as “other” due to their assumed need for conversion to American ways. Purported heathens have also contributed to the ongoing significance of the concept, promoting solidarity through their opposition to white American Christianity. Gin Lum looks to figures like Chinese American activist Wong Chin Foo and Ihanntonwan Dakota writer Zitkála-Šá, who proudly claimed the label of “heathen” for themselves. Race continues to operate as a heathen inheritance in the United States, animating Americans’ sense of being a world apart from an undifferentiated mass of needy, suffering peoples. *Heathen* thus reveals a key source of American exceptionalism and a prism through which Americans have defined themselves as a progressive and humanitarian nation even as supposed heathens have drawn on the same to counter this national myth.

**Pliny the Elder and the Emergence of Renaissance Architecture** Peter Fane-

Saunders.2016-07-12 *The Naturalis historia* by Pliny the Elder provided Renaissance scholars, artists and architects with details of ancient architectural practice and long-lost architectural wonders - material that was often unavailable elsewhere in classical literature. Pliny's descriptions frequently included the dimensions of these buildings, as well as details of their unusual construction materials and ornament. This book describes, for the first time, how the passages were interpreted from around 1430 to 1580, that is, from Alberti to Palladio. Chapters are arranged chronologically within three interrelated sections - antiquarianism; architectural writings; drawings and built monuments - thereby making it possible for the reader to follow the changing attitudes to Pliny over the period. **Marginality, Canonicity, Passion** Marco Formisano,Christina Shuttleworth Kraus.2018 In recent years, the discipline of Classics has been experiencing a profound transformation affecting not only its methodologies and hermeneutic practices - how classicists read and interpret ancient literature - but also, and more importantly, the objects of classical study themselves. One of the most important factors has been the establishment of reception studies, examining the ways in which classical literature and culture have been appropriated or responded to in later ages and/or non-western cultures. This temporal and cultural expansion beyond the 'traditional' remit of the field has had many salutary effects, but reception studies are not without limitations: of particular consequence is a tendency to focus almost exclusively on the most canonical Greek and Latin texts which is partly due to the sheer scale on which they have been received, adapted, discussed, and alluded to since antiquity. By definition, reception studies are uninterested in texts which have had no 'success', but

the result of an implicit adoption of canonicity as an unspoken criterion is the marginalization of other texts which, despite their inherent value, have not experienced so significant a *Nachleben*. This volume seeks to move beyond the questions of what is central, what is marginal, and why, to explore instead the range and significance of the classical canon and the processes by which it is shaped and changed by its reception in different academic and cultural environments. By examining the academic study of Classics from the interrelated titular perspectives of marginality, canonicity, and passion, it aims to unveil their many subtle implications and reopen a discussion not only about what makes the discipline unique, but also about what direction it might take in the future.

In addition, a number of individuals are known to have read the text or have been indirectly influenced by it, including: Vussin, Hrabanus Maurus, Hermann of Reichenau, Hugo of St. Victor, Gervase of Melkey, William of Malmesbury, Theoderich of St. Trond, Petrus Diaconus, Albertus Magnus, Filippo Villani, Jean de Montreuil, Petrarch, Boccaccio, Giovanni de Dondi, Domenico di Bandino, Niccolo Acciaoli bequeathed copy to the Basilica of San Lorenzo, Florence, Bernward of Hildesheim, and St. Thomas Aquinas. **Stereotomy** José Calvo-López.2020-08-08 This book deals with the general concepts in stereotomy and its connection with descriptive geometry, the social background of its practitioners and theoreticians, the general methods and tools of this technology, and the specific procedures for the members built in hewn stone, including arches, squinches, stairs and vaults, ending with a chapter discussing the open problems in this field. **Vitruvius** Indra Kagis McEwen.2004-09-17 A historical study of Vitruvius's *De architectura*, showing that his purpose in writing the whole body of architecture was shaped by the imperial Roman project of world domination. Included is an examination of the famous statue of Augustus from *Prima Porta*, sculpted soon after the appearance of *De architectura*.
