*Die Schätze der Erde* Eckart Olshausen, Vera Sauer. 2012 English summary: The 10th International Colloquium for the Historical Geography of Antiquity in Stuttgart dealt with the natural resources of the ancient world. The riches of the earth, with which the contributions to the proceedings of the colloquium were concerned, are in particular metals (copper, silver, gold, iron, and lead), salt, soils and agriculture, plants and animals (cereal grains, wine, olives, fish), tanning and dyeing agents, but also hydrocarbons, pearls and various goods. Therefore, those most divergent aspects associated with these riches were investigated. Besides the political implications, in the broadest sense, there are also the essential questions about the distribution, acquisition and use of raw materials, which concern the technological as well as the organizational- especially in agriculture and mining. Die Frage nach der Anwendung Thules, der Funktion und Bedeutung für das jeweilige Werk wird dabei im Fokus der Hausarbeit stehen. Thule sowie Pytheas wurden in seiner *Geographiká* mehrmals erwähnt, weswegen Quellenausschnitte aus diesem Werk zur Beantwortung der Frage genutzt werden können. Ebenfalls herangezogen werden soll Tacitus' *De vita Iulii Agricola* in der von Thule gesprochen wurde. Die Einbeziehung erfolgt aufgrund der Tatsache, dass Tacitus den einzigen weiteren bekannten Versuch aus der Antike Thule zu erreichen dokumentierte
