Monastic Spaces and Their Meanings Megan Cassidy-Welch.2001 Medieval Cistercians distinguished between material and imagined space, while the landscapes in which they lived were perceived as both physical sites and abstract topographies. Ostensibly, Cistercians lived in intensely regulated and confined physical circumstances in accordance with ideals of enclosure articulated in the Regula S. Benedicti. However, Cistercian representations of space also express ideas of transcendence and freedom. The Spirit of Simplicity Jean-Baptiste Chautard.2017-11-10 Few people have ever seen or heard of *The Spirit of Simplicity*: it has been hidden for almost seventy years after quietly being published by the Abbey of Gethsemani in 1948. Imagining the Human Condition in Medieval Rome Kristin B. Aavitsland.2017-03-08 The first monograph on the Vita Humana cycle at Tre Fontane, this book includes an overview of the medieval history of the Roman Cistercian abbey and its architecture, as well as a consideration of the political and cultural standing of the abbey both within Papal Rome and within the Cistercian order.
