Her mother, Andrea Swift Warburg, married Sidney Kaufman, but their unlikely union, Weber believes, was a direct consequence of George Gershwin's looming presence in the Warburg family. A notorious womanizer, Weber's father was a peripatetic filmmaker who made propaganda and training films for the OSS during World War II before producing the first movie with smells, the regrettable flop that was *AromaRama*. He was as much an enigma to his daughter as he was to the FBI, which had him under surveillance for more than forty years, and even noted Katharine's birth in a memo to J. Edgar Hoover. Colorful, evocative, insightful, and very funny, *The Memory of All That* is an enthralling look at a tremendously influential—and highly eccentric—family, as well as a consideration of how their stories,

with their myriad layers of truth and fiction, have both provoked and influenced one of our most prodigiously gifted writers.
