Sie erschien 1915 und gehörte zu den Texten, für die Bunin im Jahre 1933 als erster russischer Dichter den Literaturnobelpreis bekam. Dieser Sammelband vereinigt Beiträge zu Entstehungs- und Übersetzungsfragen der Novelle, zur Werkinterpretation sowie zur vergleichenden Betrachtung von genetisch und typologisch verwandten „Folientexten“ wie A. Schnitzlers „Der Fürst ist im Hause“, G. Hauptmanns „Atlantis“, J. Conrads „Typhoon“ oder V. Woolfs „The Voyage Out“. Im Anhang wird Pirandellos Novelle „Nell'albergo è morto un tale“ (1914) abgedruckt, die mehr als eine Ähnlichkeit mit der Erzählung Bunins aufweist.

Pauline Viardot-Garcia Beatrix Borchard. 2016-03-07 Universelle Musikalität, unermüdliche Arbeitslust, Leichtigkeit, Witz und Humor kennzeichnen eine der einflussreichsten Musikerinnen des 19. Jahrhunderts. Pauline Viardot-Garcia (1821-1910) war Sängerin, Gesangslehrerin, Komponistin, Arrangeurin, Pianistin, Organistin, Volksmusiksammlerin, Herausgeberin und Veranstalterin. Als eine wahrhaft europäische Erscheinung verknüpfte sie unterschiedliche Kulturen und musikalische Sprachen miteinander. Hineingeboren in die Familie des spanischen Tenors Manuel del Pópulo García führte sie deren musikalische Tradition weiter. Auf den großen Opernbühnen Europas - in Paris, London, Berlin oder Sankt Petersburg - feierte die Viardot triumphale Erfolge. Als Mitschaffende war sie nicht nur an zahlreichen Kompositionen von Zeitgenossen wie Gounod, Berlioz, Meyerbeer, Massenet, Fauré u.a. beteiligt, sondern auch an literarischen Werken. Mit dem russischen Schriftsteller Ivan Turgenew, der sein Leben und seine Arbeit untrennbar mit ihr verknüpfte, lebte sie eine Schaffensgemeinschaft, an der auch ihr Mann Louis Viardot beteiligt war. Für dieses Buch sind eine Fülle bisher unbekannter Quellen aufgespürt und ausgewertet worden, vor allem Kompositionen, Bearbeitungen, Niederschriften, Skizzen und Briefe. Sie erlauben einen neuen Blick auf das Leben und die Arbeit von Pauline Viardot-Garcia.

Sophia Tolstoy Alexandra Popoff.2010-05-11 As Leo Tolstoy's wife, Sophia Tolstoy experienced both glory and condemnation during their forty-eight-year marriage. Having modeled his most memorable female characters on her, Tolstoy admired his wife's boundless energy, which he called "the force of life." Sophia's letters, never before translated, illuminate the couple's true relationship and provide insights into Tolstoy's creative laboratory. Although long portrayed as an elitist and hysterical countess, Sophia was in reality a practical, independent-minded, generous, and talented woman who shared Tolstoy's important values and his capacity for work. Mother of thirteen, she participated in Tolstoy's causes and managed all business affairs. Popoff describes in haunting detail the intrusion into their marriage by Tolstoy's religious disciple Vladimir Chertkov, who controlled Tolstoy at the end of his life and led a smear campaign against Sophia, branding her evil and mad. She is still judged by Chertkov's false accounts, which dismissed her valuable achievements and contributions. During his later religious phase, Tolstoy renounced his property and copyright, and Sophia had to become the breadwinner. She published Tolstoy's collected works and supported their large family. Despite the pressures of her demanding life, she realized her own talents as a writer, photographer, translator, and aspiring artist. This vigorous, engrossing biography presents in fascinating depth and detail the many ways in which Sophia Tolstoy enriched the life and work of one of the world's most revered authors.

Literature Redeemed Nicolas Dreyer.2020-07-13 In the post-Soviet period, discussions of postmodernism in Russian literature have proliferated. The Blizzard Vladimir Sorokin.2015-12 Vladimir Sorokin is one of Russia's most popular novelists, and one of its most provocative as well. Agnes Von Lilien (Vollständige Ausgabe) Karoline von Wolzogen. 2018-04-05 Der Roman *Agnes von Lilien* ist die Geschichte eines empfindsamen und allem Schönen gegenüber aufgeschlossenen schwärmerischen Mädchens, das sich in der realen Welt jedoch fremd und unverstanden fühlt und sich zu einem Idealmann, der alle Tugenden in sich vereint, hingezogen fühlt.
