Christian Dotremont Nathalie Aubert.2012-02-01 Poète belge de langue française, Christian Dotremont (1922-1979) a poursuivi, tant au sein des grandes avant-gardes artistiques du XXe siècle (le surréalisme, le surréalisme-révolutionnaire et Cobra) qu'individuellement, une recherche personnelle qui l'a placé non seulement au coeur des débats littéraires et philosophiques de son temps, mais aussi, comme nombre d'artistes de sa génération, au centre des débats éthiques et politiques. Cet ouvrage retrace l'intégralité de son parcours.

La Carte postale Jacques Derrida.2014-10-01T00:00:00+02:00 « Vous pourriez lire ces envois comme la préface d'un livre que je n'ai pas écrit. Il aurait traité de ce qui va des postes, des postes en tous genres, à la psychanalyse. Moins pour tenter une psychanalyse de l'effet postal que pour renvoyer d'un singulier événement, la psychanalyse freudienne, à une histoire et à une technologie du courrier, à quelque théorie générale de l'envoi et de tout ce qui par quelque télécommunication prétend se destiner. » J.D. Le 2 juin 1977, Derrida tombe en arrêt devant une carte postale représentant Socrate et Platon, extraite d'un livre de cartomancie du xiii^e siècle. Cette image, qui lui fait l'effet d'une révélation, va nourrir, par le biais d'une longue correspondance amoureuse, une réflexion sur les relations de la parole et de l'écriture, qui prendra la forme d'« Envois », avant d'introduire trois autres chapitres du volume, et inspirera ce commentaire à Philippe Boyer : « Dans la littérature comme dans l'agriculture, les grands principes veulent que chacun reste chez soi pour que les vaches soient bien gardées. Aux romanciers les

romans, aux gastronomes les livres de cuisine, aux philosophes la philosophie... Mais que se passe-t-il lorsque soudain Jacques Derrida s'avise de prendre la littérature à bras-le-corps et d'accoucher d'un roman d'amour là où on attendait une somme théorique ? » (Libération) © Flammarion, 1980. © Flammarion, 2014, pour la présente édition.

La symbolique du regard Éric Mansfield. 2009 Le regard, élément constitutif de l'appréhension du moi, et donc la connaissance de notre propre personne, mais aussi lien vers l'extérieur, de représentation du monde, est étudié sous la lumière de la poétique. Une poétique qui a ici ses propres bornes. Spatiales tout d'abord, avec une limite aux territoires de la Martinique, Guadeloupe et Guyane, mais aussi temporelles avec une amplitude de trente-sept années entre 1945 et 1982. L'auteur tend à mettre en relation la vie des auteurs avec leur oeuvre, les thématiques mises en scène et les méthodes utilisées pour venir à leurs fins. Ouvert sur lui-même mais surtout sur les autres, cet ouvrage possède lui aussi une vision sur l'extérieur concise et pertinente. Tout est fait pour faciliter l'entrée dans cet univers pour tous les lecteurs. Les définitions d'usage sont apportées, les thématiques renseignées et explicitées, les poèmes classifiés et analysés, les schémas explicatifs ajustés, pour que le regard porté sur cette lecture n'en soit que plus appréhendable.

Poésie planétaire Julien Knebusch. 2012 Si aujourd'hui, la mondialisation atteste de notre ouverture croissante au monde, il nous faut encore apprendre à percevoir et à sentir en dehors du cadre de la nation : la conscience mondiale ne va pas de soi. La littérature et en particulier la poésie ont été à l'avant-garde des mutations dans les représentations du monde au début du XXe siècle, à un moment où les échanges culturels et économiques s'intensifient et où la révolution des transports et des télécommunications modifient notre environnement planétaire. Mais comment comprendre l'ouverture au monde des poètes ? Quelles convergences communes se dessinent dans leur poésie

lorsqu'elle s'ouvre au monde ? Cet angle d'approche des textes poétiques permet de réévaluer le cosmopolitisme et la culture internationale de ces écrivains qui ont tenté par diverses voies de concilier l'ouverture à la diversité et l'exigence de l'unité du monde, sans oublier l'ancrage dans des lieux et une culture donnés.--Page 4 de la couverture.

LA POESIE ELEMENTAIRE. Défense et illustration

.2013-08-26 Ce volume rassemble les textes de Didier Moulinier portant sur l'esthétique et la poésie dite « élémentaire », concept qu'il revendique et reconstruit ici à la fois théoriquement, historiquement et pratiquement. La « Poésie élémentaire » désigne un courant plus ou moins spécifique et tentaculaire à travers le vaste continent des poésies dites « concrètes » (visuelles et sonores) et « performatives », pratiques extrêmement variées dont l'« élémentaire » pourrait bien représenter comme une idée directrice ou une sorte de fil rouge. Cet ouvrage défend et illustre - modestement mais librement et radicalement - une posture distanciée face à la « chose poétique », réservant la primeur au pastiche et au ready-made. Une bonne partie de ces textes furent écrits par D. M. dans les années 1980-90, alors que son activité d'éditeur « underground » battait son plein, et certes il ne sera pas inutile de les resituer dans leur contexte. Pour autant si ces recherches et expérimentations ne peuvent prétendre illustrer une quelconque « actualité » artistique ou poétique, elles n'en demeurent pas moins frayantes, décapantes et assurément contemporaines. Deux grands ensembles structurent cet ouvrage : une première partie théorique dite de défense (« Introduction à la Poésie élémentaire », articles) et une seconde dite d'illustration pratique (« Mélanges et pastiches », poèmes).

Si le public reste longtemps perplexe devant la « diversité systématique » de ses écrits - romans, lipogrammes, palindromes, autobiographie, mots croisés, poésies, drames radiophoniques, récits de rêves, essais et ouvrages inclassables comme Je me souviens - Georges Perec s'impose avec son chef-d'œuvre, La Vie mode d'emploi, qui renouvelle profondément l'art du roman. Récit d'une vie consacrée à la réinvention de l'écriture, la biographie de David Bellos est tout à la fois une chronique scrupuleuse, une interprétation sensible et un panorama de la culture française à l'apogée des Trente Glorieuses. Entièrement revue et mise à jour grâce aux derniers apports de la recherche, cette nouvelle édition est le complément indispensable d'une œuvre littéraire enfin reconnue comme une des plus innovantes du XXe siècle.

Translating the Perception of Text Clive Scott.2017-07-05

Translation often proceeds as if languages already existed, as if the task of the translator were to make an appropriate selection from available resources. Clive Scott challenges this tacit assumption. If the translator is to do justice to himself/herself as a reader, if the translator is to become the creative writer of his/her reading, then the language of translation must be equal to the translators perceptual experience of, and bodily responses to, source texts. Each renewal of perceptual and physiological contact with a text involves a renewal of the ways we think language and use our expressive faculties (listening, speaking, writing). Phenomenology and particularly the phenomenology of Merleau-Ponty underpins this new approach to translation. The task of the translator is tirelessly to develop new translational languages, ever to move beyond the bilingual into the multilingual, and always to remember that language is as much an active instrument of perception as an object of perception.

François Augiéras Philippe Berthier.1994 François Augiéras (1925-1971) est assurément l'une des figures les plus fascinantes qui se soient détachées en ce siècle sur l'horizon de la littérature. Sans jamais se prendre pour Rimbaud, mais obéissant à une vocation profonde de nomadisme, à un goût violent du dénuement et de la précarité, Augiéras ne cessera de vagabonder au Maghreb, où il vit dangereusement et recherche les révélations du désert, ni de revenir se ressourcer dans son Périgord noir, en quête des secrets enfouis dans les grottes par les voyants du paléolithique. Attiré par les mythes de l'ancienne Egypte, par la contemplation érémitique sur les montagnes de la Grèce, par le mysticisme de l'Asie, il cherchera à toujours s'ouvrir davantage à l'écoute des pulsions du monde, attentif à y déchiffrer les signes d'un sacré immémorial. Après avoir en des livres inclassables (fictions, proses poétiques, autobiographie, récits de voyage) fait entendre un ton tout à fait étranger à la littérature telle qu'elle se
