Sie untersuchen die Darstellung von Geschichte in der mittelalterlichen deutschen Literatur auf der Basis von aktuellen erzähltheoretischen Forschungsansätzen. Dabei wird ein breites Spektrum an Texten, Gattungen und Diskursen in den Blick genommen; als Angelpunkt für zahlreiche relevante Fragestellungen erweist sich die im 12. Jahrhundert entstandene ›Kaiserchronik‹. Geleitet von der Erkenntnis, dass Vergangenheit erst im Erzählen zu Geschichte wird, analysieren die Beiträge einschlägige narrative Strategien.

Nicht zum ersten Mal, auch wenn es uns so erscheint. Wir sind eingetreten in eine Phase der Krisen: Die Pandemie wird überschattet von einem neuen Ost-West-Konflikt um die globale Führung im 21. Jahrhundert. Überdies fällt die Welt aktuell in eine schwere Wirtschaftskrise, die Existenzgrundlagen und Weltbilder aus den Angeln hebt. Welche Gefahren kommen auf uns zu? Und welche Chancen eröffnen sich? Wie erlebten Menschen früherer Zeiten solche Umbruchszeiten und welche Muster lassen sich erkennen? Unsere zweiteilige Publikation möchte den Lesern Orientierung und Hilfestellungen für die nun angebrochene Zeit des fundamentalen Wandels bieten. Im Fokus steht dabei sowohl die Sicherung der materiellen Lebensgrundlagen (äußeres Vermögen) als auch die Entfaltung mentaler Stärke, um Umbruchszeiten proaktiv nutzen zu können (inneres Vermögen). Im 1. Teil (»Zeitenwende und Vermögen: Beständig ist allein der Wandel«) schauen wir zunächst in die Vergangenheit und geben einen Überblick über vergleichbare Umbruchsphasen der letzten Jahrhunderte.

Wiederkehrende Strukturen des Wandels werden dabei sichtbar und schaffen Orientierung. Vieles von heute erkennen wir dabei wieder und so eröffnet uns die Rückschau in der Gegenwart, was potenziell vor uns in der Zukunft liegt. Auf dieser Grundlage veranschaulichen wir dann im 2. Teil (»Zeitenwende und Vermögen: Chancen des Wandels«) die großen gegenwärtigen und zukünftigen Trends in Gesellschaft, Ökonomie und Weltpolitik. Gefahren und Chancen können so ausgemacht und gewinnbringend verwandelt werden. Wie lässt sich die Zeitenwende konkret nutzen, um bisherige Grenzen zu überwinden? Welche Lösungsmethoden, Checklisten und To-Do-Listen gibt es, um selbst von dramatischen Entwicklungen noch persönlich und familiär zu profitieren? Zeiten des Umbruchs, ob familiär oder gesellschaftlich, stellen erhebliche mentale Herausforderungen dar. Beide Teile behandeln somit auch das Vermögen, Krisenzeiten mit geistiger Stärke zu meistern und dabei persönliche Potenziale zu entfalten. Außerdem geht es um die Frage, wie wir unser generationales Erbe und die Lebensbedingungen unserer Kinder gestalten, wenn wir die epochale Zeitenwende bewusst in den Blick nehmen. Die zweiteilige Publikation fordert Sie auf und hilft Ihnen konkret, das eigene Schicksal und das Ihrer Anvertrauten bewusst und beherrscht in die Hand zu nehmen und über bisherige Grenzen hinaus zu dem Menschen zu werden, der bislang nur potenziell existiert und darauf wartet, in Erscheinung zu treten.

This theme has become increasingly fragmented in recent decades, resulting in scholars being largely unaware of developments outside their own areas. The present volume brings together historians and archaeologists in order to highlight the varied ways in which town-country interactions can be considered, from perspectives that include economy, politics, natural environment, material culture, and settlement hierarchy. As a whole, the papers offer innovative interdisciplinary perspectives on the topic that create a new platform from which to understand more fully the complex, bilateral relationships in which both urban and rural spheres were able to influence and challenge each other. Meine Ur-Oma in der Buschschule Hans Fink. 2022-07-15 Der Brauch war so alt, dass er Eingang in die griechische Mythologie gefunden hat, und zwar in Form der Geschichte vom Mädchen Kore, das vom Gott Hades in die Unterwelt verschleppt wird. Tatsächlich kletterten die eingeschulten Knaben und Mädchen in einen brunnenartigen Schacht und befanden sich dann angeblich in der Unterwelt. Für ihre Verwandten galten sie als gestorben. In der Buschschule wurden sie mit den Pflichten und Rechten eines Stammesmitglieds vertraut gemacht und rituell in Erwachsene verwandelt. Zugleich damit war der Brauch so zäh, dass er in Mitteleuropa bis ins frühe Mittelalter von Generation zu Generation weitergereicht wurde, trotz der unzähligen Wanderungen, Kriege, Seuchen und Hungersnöte. Erst nach der Verbreitung des Christentums haben die Menschen auf ihn verzichtet. In Rumänien und in der Ukraine überlebte er in Form der Mädchen-Spinnstube bis ins 20. Jahrhundert. Nach dem Verschwinden des Brauchs aus der sozialen Wirklichkeit begann man von ihm zu erzählen - in der Späten Bronzezeit entstanden die Urformen unserer Zaubermärchen, im Mittelalter die Sagen von den hilfreichen Zwergen und Saligen Fräulein. In der europäischen Folklore sind die Zaubermärchen von den geraubten Königstöchtern außerordentlich gut vertreten. Deshalb wählte der Autor sie als Ausgangsbasis bei dem Versuch, den Brauch zu rekonstruieren.

Citizenship and Empire in Europe 200-1900 Clifford Ando. 2015-11-18 In 212 CE, the emperor Caracalla extended citizenship to nearly all free-born residents of the Roman Empire. In doing so, he transformed not only his own, but the very ideal of empire and statehood in Europe. This volume first inquires into the contexts of Caracalla's act in his own day. Rome was an ancient empire: it had traditionally ruled over populations that were conceived and governed as distinct units, a practice that was both strategic and ideological. What were the practical and political effects of a universalizing ideology in this context? Was there a reorientation of private social and legal practice in response? And what politics of exclusion came to apply, now that citizenship no longer served to distinguish persons of higher and lower status? The volume subsequently traces the history of citizenship in universalizing ideologies and legal practice from late antiquity to the codification of law in Europe in the nineteenth century. Caracalla's act was then repeatedly cited as the ideal toward which sovereign polities should strive, be they states or empires. Citizenship and law were thereby made preeminent among the universalisms of European statecraft.
