In fact, his photographs remain so popular that they are still used today with regularity by the aviation press. weapons such as the machine gun, the tank and the airplane, profoundly transformed modern warfare.

Campbell.2014-07-11 The first U.S. Navy aerial photographs were taken in 1913 in support of fleet exercises off Guantanamo, Cuba. The 74 year odyssey of Navy and Marine Corps aerial reconnaissance photography was finished.
