He wanted his friars to be joculars Dei ('the minstrels of God'). *The Little Flowers* is translated from the 'Fioretti', an Italian translation of a Latin original of which the earliest extant manuscript is one of 1390. It is a narration of miracle and hymn connected with the saint and his friars. *The Mirror of Perfection* is based on documents and memoirs left by Friar Leo, St Francis's favourite disciple, and was completed about 1318. St Bonaventure wrote the *Life of St Francis* c. 1260, intending it to stand as an authoritative *Life* and to supersede the numerous fragmentary biographies then in circulation.
