Knowledge of Life Georges Canguilhem.2008 As the work of thinkers such as Michel Foucault, François Jacob, Louis Althusser, and Pierre Bourdieu demonstrates, Georges Canguilhem has exerted tremendous influence on the philosophy of science and French philosophy more generally. In *Knowledge of Life*, a book that spans twenty years of his essays and lectures, Canguilhem offers a series of epistemological histories that seek to establish and clarify the stakes, ambiguities, and emergence of philosophical and biological concepts that defined the rise of modern biology. How do transformations in biology and modern medicine shape conceptions of life? Le normal et le pathologique à l'école aujourd'hui Laurence Gavarini, Dominique Ottavi, Ilaria Pirone, Doris Bühler-Niederberger, Marina D'Amato.2022 À la croisée de la philosophie, de la psychanalyse et de la sociologie, cet ouvrage invite à réinterpréter les écarts à la norme, les problèmes disciplinaires, les différents troubles de l'attention et pathologies repérées chez l'enfant et l'adolescent dans le champ scolaire. Comment se départagent le normal et le pathologique aujourd'hui à l'école ? La norme scolaire a changé d'aspect, et son poids s'exerce alors même que l'école vise l'inclusion des différences et le respect de l'égalité. La neuropédagogie et la psychologie cognitive sont devenues des incontournables et exercent une influence hégémonique sur la didactique. Sans défendre un autre discours totalisant en miroir des précédents, mais au contraire dans une forme de dialogue, les différentes contributions montrent comment une approche clinique est requise pour déceler des tensions entre les idéaux et ce qui se joue effectivement dans les pratiques. Tout comme une réflexion philosophique est aussi nécessaire pour mettre en question les finalités de l'école, et leur transformation. Que se passe-t-il donc sous nos yeux, pour que les intentions louables qui soutiennent les pratiques dites inclusives à l'école s'accompagnent d'un sentiment récurrent de crise et de souffrances dans l'espace scolaire ? En intégrant des contributions d'universitaires sociologues et de cliniciens allemands et italiens, l'ouvrage se penche sur la manière dont, parfois à l'insu des acteurs, le poids d'exigences nouvelles pèse sur les élèves, alors même que les objectifs déclarés de l'éducation s'arment de bienveillance et appellent au respect du développement naturel.

La connaissance de la vie Georges Canguilhem.1985 Qu'est-ce que l'expérimentation en biologie ? Quelle différence y a-t-il entre un organisme et une machine ? Que faut-il entendre par normal et par pathologique ? Dans ce recueil d'articles consacrés à la médecine et aux sciences biologiques, Georges Canguilhem passe en revue un certain nombre de questions soulevées par la vie et les diverses manières de la représenter. Il montre comment, dans les théories du vivant, s'articulent, selon des configurations souvent complexes, la prise en compte des données de l'observation et l'influence du contexte culturel, philosophique et même parfois politique. L'ouvrage donne ainsi à comprendre que la biologie, comme toute autre science d'ailleurs, n'est pas issue de la seule observation des faits. Lectures de Canguilhem Guillaume Le Blanc.2000 Nietzsche a pu écrire que la philosophie était

affaire de santé plutôt que de vérité, désignant à la pensée la tâche de saisir ce qu'il en est de la vie. Toute perspective sur la vie ne peut elle-même être qu'une perspective vitale. « Le normal et le pathologique » de Canguilhem parvient à une conclusion voisine. La vérité des énoncés biologiques et médicaux ne prend sens que rapportée aux expériences vécues de l'homme sain et de l'homme malade. De fait, le livre de Canguilhem propose, à partir de modélisations épistémologiques toujours précisées, une philosophie de la vie. Après Nietzsche et Bergson, tout autant avec eux que contre eux, Canguilhem cherche à ressaisir la vie non seulement par le maintien des normes mais plus encore par leur renouvellement. Tandis que la santé correspond à une tolérance maximale, la maladie limite les capacités des vivants au point de susciter cet art de la correction qu'est la médecine. Une pensée de la médecine peut alors être entrevue en tant que productrice d'un nouveau normal et activité de résistance à la pathologie. Ceci suppose toutefois de comprendre l'acte médical comme un acte éthique alors même que la formulation d'une éthique médicale induit des effets normalisateurs dénoncés par Canguilhem. Restituer au livre de Canguilhem toute son actualité philosophique, tel est l'enjeu de ce recueil.

On the Normal and the Pathological Georges Canguilhem.2012-12-06 by MICHEL FOUCAULT

Everyone knows that in France there are few logicians but many historians of science; and that in the 'philosophical establishment' - whether teaching or research oriented - they have occupied a considerable position. But do we know precisely the importance that, in the course of these past fifteen or twenty years, up to the very frontiers of the establishment, a 'work' like that of Georges Canguilhem can have had for those very people who were separated from, or challenged, the establishment? Yes, I know, there have been noisier theatres: psychoanalysis, Marxism, linguistics, ethnology. But let us not forget this fact which depends, as you will, on the sociology of French intellectual environments, the functioning of our university institutions or our system of cultural values: in all the political or scientific discussions of these strange sixty years past, the role of the 'philosophers' - I simply mean those who had received their university training in philosophy department- has been important: perhaps too important for the liking of certain people. And, directly or indirectly, all or almost all these philosophers have had to 'come to terms with' the teaching and books of Georges Canguilhem. From this, a paradox: this man, whose work is austere, intentionally and carefully limited to a particular domain in the history of science, which in any case does not pass for a spectacular discipline, has somehow found himself present in discussions where he himself took care never to figure.

Ideology and Rationality in the History of the Life Sciences Georges Canguilhem.1988

Throughout his long career Canguilhem has been concerned with the way in which ideas originate and become transformed in scientific discourse, and with the role played by ideological factors in determining the direction if not the results of scientific work. This book collects his published essays of the 1970s.

Cette critique de l'objectivisme médical est étroitement liée chez Canguilhem avec une réflexion sur la normativité de la vie. Depuis 1943, le contexte de discussion a bien changé. Le contexte scientifique a aussi considérablement changé. Pour ne citer que quelques exemples, la notion épidémiologique de facteur de risque a discrédité l'idée d'une démarcation claire entre phénomènes normaux et phénomènes pathologiques ; la génétique médicale, l'immunologie, la médecine des troubles mentaux ont par ailleurs bouleversé l'explication, la nosologie et la prise en charge des pathologies. Enfin, la médicalisation croissante des sociétés contemporaines se traduit par une pathologisation d'innombrables problèmes dont la solution était

traditionnellement sociale plutôt que médicale. Ce livre a pour ambition d'évaluer dans quelle mesure les catégories du normal et du pathologique ont connu une mutation et si elles sont toujours d'actualité.

La nouvelle édition de ce classique dans le domaine de la psychopathologie représente la synthèse des recherches qui ont valu aux hypothèses de Jean Bergeret de nombreux échos et échanges. Il fonde les travaux ultérieurs de l'auteur consacrés aux états-limites, à la dépression, à la toxicomanie et à la notion de violence fondamentale.

Normality Peter Cryle, Elizabeth Stephens.2017-12 Most of us think we know what is meant when we hear the term normal," but Cryle and Stephens upend taken-for-granted attitudes about the term. They offer a history of the intellectual and cultural issues that have been at stake in the use of the term since it appeared around 1820. What is taken at one time or any one culture to be aberrant" or deviant" clearly depends on assumed meanings for norm and normality. The authors of this book explore this history--peppered with a fascinating series of case studies--to make sense of variations on the theme of identity (disability, gender, race, sexuality) in fields organized around identity. They locate the concept in the scientific spheres where it originated in its modern sense and they chart its transformations and developments from the 1820s in France (medicine) to the mid-20th century (Alfred Kinsey). They start with comparative anatomy and other branches of medicine before moving on to consider developments in fields as remote as craniometry, statistics, criminal anthropology, sociology, and eugenics. It is not enough to say, with David Halperin, that "queer" is whatever is at odds with the normal, the legitimate, the dominant." Cryle and Stephens move beyond a simple binary opposition between normal" and abnormality" to give us the whole picture, from the Continent to the U.S., and in all the contexts that distinguish the normal from other available terms (such as typical, average, respectable, conventional, white and heterosexual, and uniform). Normality" has had a long struggle to secure its cultural dominance and authority, a story which is told here for the first time.
