This shift challenges our vertically-structured response to terror and places a greater emphasis on mastering the virtual, cyber-based dimensions of these campaigns. Mckinlay revisits the roots of global insurgencies, describes their nature and character, reveals the power of mass communications and grievance, and recommends how individual nations can counter these threats by focusing on domestic terrorism.

After the publication of the *Pirotechnia*, many followed Biringuccio's example, and as a result of this growing literature of technological practice and experimental fact, science eventually became the

concern of the educated man.
