**Baking With Kafka** Tom Gauld.2021-05-04 In his inimitable style, British cartoonist Tom Gauld has opened comics to a crossover audience and challenged perceptions of what the medium can be. Simmonds' penchant for literary pastiche and parody is given full rein, as in 'Murder at Matabele Mansions'.
