Slave Portraiture in the Atlantic World Agnes Lugo-Ortiz, Angela Rosenthal. 2013-09-30 *Slave Portraiture in the Atlantic World* is the first book to focus on the individualized portrayal of enslaved people from the time of Europe's full engagement with plantation slavery in the late sixteenth century to its final official abolition in Brazil in 1888. From Collegiate, Dan-el went on to Princeton, where he made the momentous decision to come out as an undocumented student in a Wall Street Journal profile a few months before he gave the salutatorian's traditional address in Latin at his commencement.
