Between Rome and Babylon Aharon Oppenheimer, Aharon Oppenheimer. 2005 *Between Rome and Babylon* includes over thirty papers by Aharon Oppenheimer about Jewish life in Palestine and Babylonia in the period of the Mishnah and the Talmud (1st-4th centuries), dealing with leadership and society, political and military activity, relations with the authorities and historical geography. The collection is organized around three inter-connected themes: 1 Roman Palestine and its Environs; 2 The Bar Kokhba Revolt; 3 Babylonia Judaica. About two-thirds of the papers were originally published in Hebrew. They have been selected and edited for this collection, and translated for the first time into English or German. The rest of the papers originally appeared in various different languages and contexts, and they too have been selected and edited to fit the three themes. Cross-references have been added, as well as detailed indices. The aim of the papers is to cast light on Jewish history by extracting methodically historical meaning from Talmudic sources, taking into account when they were written, where they were edited, and how far they can be presumed authentic; and by looking at them in combination with Greek, Roman, Persian and Arabic written sources as well as relevant archaeological finds.

In his introduction, the editor calls for a reappraisal of the terms of German-Jewish discourse away from the notion of 'Germans' and 'Jews' and towards the idea that both Jews and non-Jews, all of them Germans, have contributed to the corpus of 'German-Jewish literature'.

Geschichte der neuzeitlichen jüdischen Gemeinde in Duderstadt Götz Hütt.2012 Die Geschichte der neuzeitlichen jüdischen Gemeinde in Duderstadt ist ein Beispiel für das Leben einer jüdischen Minderheit in kleinstädtischem Milieu während des 19. und 20. Jahrhunderts. Vor 200 Jahren, im Herbst 1812, zogen fünf jüdische Familien nach Duderstadt und gründeten hier eine jüdische Gemeinde. Sie wurden als Fremde wahrgenommen, erschienen höchst unwillkommen, mussten aber auf Grund der liberalen Gesetze des Königreichs Westfalen geduldet werden. Sepulcra judaica Falk Wiesemann.2005 Seit den biblischen Zeiten sind die Sorge um Kranke und Sterbende sowie die Verpflichtung, die Toten zu bestatten und zu betrauern, als substantielle Elemente der religiös bestimmten Sozialordnung des Judentums dokumentiert. Religion and Illness Annette Weissenrieder, Gregor Etzelmüller. 2016-11-04 What are the relevant conceptualities and terminologies marking the coupling of religion and medical interpretations of illness in different religions such as Judaism, Islam, Buddhism, and Christianity? How do religious orientations influence courses of a disease? How do experiences of illness change images of the divine in late modernity? The Jewish Body Robert Jütte. 2020-11-27 An encyclopedic survey of the Jewish body as it has

existed and as it has been imagined from biblical times to the present That the human body can be the object not only of biological study but also of historical consideration and cultural criticism is now widely accepted. But why, Robert Jütte asks, should a historian bother with the Jewish body in particular?
