Human Rights Approaches to Environmental Protection Alan E. Boyle, Michael R. Anderson. 1998 This collection of essays explores links between the environment and human rights, and responds to the growing debate among activists, lawyers, academics and policy-makers on the legal status of environmental rights in both international and domestic law, and on the proposals for a human right to a satisfactory environment. The collection is an original and timely contribution to the existing literature on this subject, and offers a sustained analysis which addresses both the conceptual and practical problems of environmental rights. The conceptual dimensions are particularly rich, raising fundamental questions concerning the human/environment relationship as well as more general issues regarding the form, content and limitations of international and domestic human rights law. The first part of the book deals mainly with the protection of the environment in international human rights law and EC law, while part two concentrates on problems and experience in developing countries, some of which have already incorporated environmental rights and international constitutional law and from which a growing jurisprudence has emerged. This is where at present human rights approaches seem to be of greatest value. Each chapter is written by an author well qualified in the field. The volume will have a wide appeal to anyone interested in environmental law and human rights.

Justice in Robes Ronald Dworkin. 2008-04-30 How should a judge's moral convictions bear on his judgments about what the law is? Lawyers, sociologists, philosophers, politicians, and judges all have answers to that question: these range from "nothing" to

Everything. In *Justice in Robes*, Ronald Dworkin argues that the question is much more complex than it has often been taken to be and charts a variety of dimensions—semantic, jurisprudential, and doctrinal—in which law and morals are undoubtedly interwoven. He restates and summarizes his own widely discussed account of these connections, which emphasizes the sovereign importance of moral principle in legal and constitutional interpretation, and then reviews and criticizes the most influential rival theories to his own. He argues that pragmatism is empty as a theory of law, that value pluralism misunderstands the nature of moral concepts, that constitutional originalism reflects an impoverished view of the role of a constitution in a democratic society, and that contemporary legal positivism is based on a mistaken semantic theory and an erroneous account of the nature of authority. In the course of that critical study he discusses the work of many of the most influential lawyers and philosophers of the era, including Isaiah Berlin, Richard Posner, Cass Sunstein, Antonin Scalia, and Joseph Raz. Dworkin's new collection of essays and original chapters is a model of lucid, logical, and impassioned reasoning that will advance the crucially important debate about the roles of justice in law.

The Significance of Territory Jean Gottmann. 1973 Over her thirty-year study of the concept of territory, Jean Gottmann has seen its significance evolve in a wide variety of ways throughout the world. Factors that influence the attitude of people toward their territory involve studies of geography, politics, and economics of a region. The importance of this entity has been defined and redefined differently by all levels of society, whether in the context of political boundaries, military use, jurisdiction and ownership, or topography characteristics. At its essence, an understanding of all aspects of territory help paint a clear picture of how individuals develop a relationship between their communities and their habitats, a subject that has been little

explored until now. The elusive nature of the concept of territory is broken down here, and the term's significance reassessed. In his analysis of Western concepts and history, Gottmann closely examines the concept of territory as a psychosomatic device, and comments on how its evolution is similar to basic human striving for security, opportunity, and happiness.

The Constitution of Deliberative Democracy Carlos Santiago Nino.1996-01-01 In this important and wide-ranging book, a leading political theorist and activist considers the question: What justifies democracy? Carlos Santiago Nino critically examines answers others have given and then develops his own distinctive theory of democracy, emphasizing its deliberative character. In Nino's view, democracy resembles a moral conversation and is valued because of its capacity to generate an impartial perspective, one that takes into account the interests of all citizens. Nino's conception of deliberative democracy bears on the way power is organized under a constitution. Drawing on a variety of constitutional traditions, he criticizes the presidential system and calls for citizens to participate more directly in the political life of their country. He also envisions a revitalized role for political parties. Nino shows how deliberative democracy can be combined with, and supported by, other constitutional practices, such as the specific wording of the text and the protection of individual rights. The complex constitution that emerges from his analysis consists of a historical constitution, an ideal constitution of rights, and an ideal constitution of power. Nino's goal is to explain how these three dimensions of constitutionalism can reinforce rather than conflict with each other. In a final chapter, he argues that the deliberative conception of democracy requires a more limited role for judicial review than is usually contemplated.

Published in 1797, the work of the self-exiled Maistre presents a providential interpretation of the French Revolution and argues for a new alliance of throne and altar under a restored Bourbon monarchy. Although the Directory and then Napoleon delayed Maistre's influence within France until the Restoration, he is now acknowledged as the most eloquent spokesperson for continental

conservatism. Considerations on France was a shrewd piece of propaganda, but, as Isaiah Berlin contends, by arguing his case in broad historical, philosophical and religious terms, Maistre raises issues of enduring importance.

En las ediciones anteriores se han comentado las Leyes del Suelo desde el año 1956 hasta el presente. La nueva edición estudia fundamentalmente la Ley 8/07, de 28 de mayo (entiéndase que las referencias a la Ley 8/2007, lo son igualmente al RDLeg. 2/2008, de 20 de junio, por el que se aprueba el Texto Refundido de la Ley de Suelo). Se sigue para ello el mismo esquema de las ediciones anteriores, para lo cual se estudia el concepto de propiedad del suelo de la nueva Ley. Esta concepción nueva supone la privación al propietario de una serie de facultades, como es el derecho a urbanizar y se llega así a una nacionalización arbitraria del suelo. Pocas novedades contiene la

Ley en cuanto a la expropiación forzosa, puesto que el objetivo fundamental de esta Ley es el sistema de valoraciones. El sistema de valoraciones del suelo, regulado en la Ley 8/07, es inconstitucional y arbitrario. La Ley pretende aplicar en un sistema constitucional de economía de mercado una excepción para la valoración del suelo con criterios irracionales. Para ello redefine el contenido del derecho a edificar que por medio de esta Ley se nacionaliza, así como el derecho a urbanizar. Sobre esta base se establece un sistema de valoraciones que se olvida del destino urbanístico del suelo y se basa en unas situaciones que olvidan las plusvalías derivadas de la clasificación. La prohibición de valorar plusvalías, la eliminación del método de comparación y la valoración por la renta agraria son instrumentos que se utilizan para esta valoración arbitraria que la Ley trata de implantar. Esta edición se refiere también al momento temporal de la valoración, al régimen transitorio y a la legislación aplicable. Creemos que este régimen de valoraciones va a ser de difícil aplicación, y además producirá una grave inseguridad jurídica.
