Mr Charles Booth's Inquiry Rosemary O'Day.1993-07-01 Charles Booth's pioneering survey, *Life and Labour of the People in London*, published in 17 volumes between 1889 and 1903, was a landmark in empirical social investigation. His panorama of London life has dominated all subsequent accounts: its scope, precision and detail make it an unrivalled source for the period. Mr. Charles Booth's *Inquiry* is the first systematic account of the making of the survey, based upon an intensive examination of the huge Booth archive. This contains far more material than was eventually published, in particular on women, work, religion, education, housing and social relations, as well as on poverty. While the book acknowledges the leading role of Booth himself, it highlights the significance of the contributions of his associates, including Beatrice Potter (Webb), Octavia Hill, Llewellyn Smith and G.H. Duckworth. *Life and Labour of the People in London* is a founding text of both social history and modern sociology. It has however commonly been misunderstood and frequently misused. Mr. Charles Booth's *Inquiry* sets the survey in perspective and demonstrates the richness of the Booth archive and its potential for modern scholarship in both history and the social sciences.

Atoms in the Family Laura Fermi.2014-10-24 In this absorbing account of life with the great atomic scientist Enrico Fermi, Laura Fermi tells the story of their emigration to the United States in the 1930s—part of the widespread movement of scientists from Europe to the New World that was so important to the development of the first atomic bomb. Combining intellectual biography and social history, Laura Fermi traces her husband's career from his childhood, when he taught himself physics, through his rise in the Italian university system concurrent with the rise of fascism, to his receipt of the Nobel Prize, which offered a perfect opportunity to flee the country without arousing official suspicion, and his odyssey to the United States.

The Nun Simonetta Agnello Hornby.2011-12-27 Winner of the Italian PEN Prize: A tale of illicit love and a girl forced into a convent in the early nineteenth century. 1839, Messina, Italy: Agata is the daughter of an aristocrat, albeit an impoverished one, and she has fallen in love with wealthy Giacomo Lepre. Van Dine. 2014-06-12 Le indagini dell'investigatore Philo Vance Philo Vance, l'investigatore creato da Van Dine, è senz'altro il più raffinato tra quelli che videro la luce negli anni Venti. Colto e affascinante, ha una sola, grande passione: l'arte. Possiede una collezione, nel suo appartamento sulla Trentottesima Est a New York, pieno di esemplari di arte orientale e occidentale. Il lettore non deve essere oggetto di trucchi e raggiri diversi da quelli che il criminale usa legittimamente nei riguardi dell'investigatore...» e via dicendo). Poi decise di buttarsi e si mise a scrivere di uno strano omicidio avvenuto a Wall Street risolto da un detective con il monocolo. Philo Vance piacque subito, e visto il grande successo del primo libro, Van Dine ne scrisse altri undici, fino

alla morte, giunta al termine di una vita tormentata ma da nababbo: grazie all'amico Vance, aveva conquistato fama e dollari a milioni. S.S. Van Dine pseudonimo di Willard Huntington Wright, nacque a Charlottesville (Virginia), nel 1888. Studiò in California e si specializzò all'Università di Harvard. Fu poi a Monaco e a Parigi per studiare arte. Nel 1907 iniziò l'attività di critico letterario e d'arte. Nel 1925 cominciò a scrivere romanzi polizieschi ed ebbe subito un successo straordinario. Il creatore del detective Philo Vance morì a New York nel 1939.

Prefaces to the Diaphora Peter Carravetta.1991 The central concern of these eight studies and essays is the understanding and critique of culture at the shifty boundaries between the Modern and the Postmodern epochs. The author contends that what needs to be addressed is the very abyss, the spacetime between the Modern and the Postmodern worldviews, as well as the tension between aesthetics and ethics, critical discourse and the creative arts, in an effort to rethink multireferential processes of signification. The keystone of the book is Carravetta's notion of Diaphoristics, a theory of interpretation as dialogue. Diaphora, or difference, refers to the ancient quarrel between poetry and philosophy and signifies the movement between asymmetrical or heterogeneous forms of discourse that have, both historically and speculatively, borne the transfer of meaning from one semantic/hermeneutic field to another. The author focuses on the necessary risk and duplicity of criticism and develops nonagonistic models based on figuration and rhetorical dynamics. In two other chapters, the author steps back to reassess, in terms of the diaphora, the diverging notions of Postmodernity by the continental philosophers Lyotard and Vattimo. The collection ends with an essay on the long-overdue conversation between Vico and Heidegger.

The Black Camel Earl Derr Biggers.2015-07-03 This early work by Earl Derr Biggers was originally published in 1929 and we are now republishing it with a brand new introductory biography. The "Black Camel" tells the story of a Hollywood star (Shelah Fane), who is stopping in Hawaii after she finished shooting a film on location in Tahiti. She is murdered in the pavilion of her renter house in Waikiki during her stay. Chan, in his position as a detective with the Honolulu Police Department,

investigates amid public clamor demanding that the murderer be found and punished immediately. "Death is a black camel that kneels unbidden at every gate. Tonight black camel has knelt here", Chan tells the suspects. Earl Derr Biggers was born on 26th August 1884 in Warren, Ohio, USA. Biggers received his further education at Harvard University, where he developed a reputation as a literary rebel, preferring the popular modern authors, such as Rudyard Kipling and Richard Harding Davis to the established figures of classical literature. Following in their footsteps upon graduating, he himself began a career as a popular writer, penning humorous articles and reviews for the Boston Traveler. While on holiday in Hawaii, Biggers heard tales of a real-life Chinese detective operating in Honolulu, named Chang Apana. This inspired him to create his most enduring legacy in the character of super-sleuth Charlie Chan. The first Chan story "The House Without a Key" (1925) was published as a serialised story in the Saturday Evening Post and then released as a novel in the same year. Biggers went on to write five more Chan novels and all were licensed for movie adaptations by Fox Films. These films were hugely popular with several different actors taking the lead role of Chan. Eventually; over 40 films were produced featuring the character. Biggers only saw the early on-screen successes of Charlie Chan due to his death at the age of only 48 from a heart attack in April 1933.
