**Il terremoto dell'Irpinia** Toni Ricciardi,Generoso Picone,Luigi Fiorentino.2020-11-09T00:00:00+01:00 Tremila morti, novemila feriti e oltre trecentomila senzatetto fanno del terremoto dell'Irpinia l'evento più catastrofico della storia repubblicana: era il 23 novembre del 1980 quando la terra cominciò a tremare, provocando in soli novanta secondi una devastazione senza precedenti. a quarant'anni da quella tragedia, questo libro ne ripercorre la storia, basandosi su un accurato lavoro di ricerca sulle fonti d'archivio, ma anche sulla memoria orale e sull'immaginario legato a quell'evento. **Immigrants in the Lands of Promise** Samuel L. Baily. 2016-11-15 Most studies of immigration to the New World have focused on the United States. Samuel L. Baily's eagerly awaited book broadens that perspective through a comparative analysis of Italian immigrants to Buenos Aires and New York City before World War I. It is one of the few works to trace Italians from their villages of origin to different destinations abroad. Baily examines the adjustment of Italians in the two cities, comparing such factors as employment opportunities, skill levels, pace of migration, degree of prejudice, and development of the Italian community. Of the two destinations, Buenos Aires offered Italians more extensive opportunities, and those who elected to move there tended to have the appropriate education or training to succeed. These immigrants, who adjusted more rapidly than their North American counterparts, adopted a long-term strategy of investing savings in their New World home. In New York, in contrast, the immigrants found fewer skilled and white-collar jobs, more competition from previous immigrant groups, greater discrimination, and a less supportive Italian enclave. As a result, rather than put down roots, many sought to earn money as rapidly as possible and send their earnings back to family in Italy. Baily views the migration process as a global phenomenon. Building on his richly documented case studies, the author briefly examines Italian communities in San Francisco, Toronto, and Sao Paulo. He establishes a continuum of immigrant adjustment in urban settings, creating a landmark study in both immigration and comparative history.

*Marcinelle, 1956* Toni Ricciardi. 2016-07-29T00:00:00+02:00 Marcinelle è comunemente riconosciuta come la catastrofe per antonomasia degli italiani all'estero. Non fu la prima né l'ultima, ma rappresenta uno dei tasselli più dolorosi del variegato mosaico della migrazione italiana nel mondo. L'incendio nella miniera di Marcinelle, avvenuto l'8 agosto 1956 - nel quale morirono 262 lavoratori di dodici nazionalità, tra cui 136 italiani -, non costituì solo l'ennesimo tributo di migranti allo sviluppo economico europeo, ma anche il momento più drammatico di un'intera epopea migratoria. Alla faticosa ricerca di un nuovo assetto istituzionale e in una condizione di incertezza totale sul proprio futuro, l'Italia, fin dal 1946, aveva gettato le basi organizzative di uno dei più imponenti sistemi di esportazione di manodopera che la recente storia occidentale ricordi. Le piazze e i bar dei paesini, da Nord a Sud, furono tappezzati di manifesti rosa che incitavano a partire per le miniere del Belgio. Parallelamente ai centri di emigrazione, si sviluppò anche la rete dei trafficanti di migranti. Regolari o irregolari, l'importante era che fossero tanti, un esercito chiamato a combattere la «battaglia del carbone», scavando nelle viscere della terra quella risorsa necessaria al rilancio economico dell'Europa. Molti, dopo i primi mesi, rimpatriarono o furono arrestati per il rifiuto di sottostare alle condizioni disumane su cui Bruxelles e Roma si erano accordate: un flusso di almeno 2000 minatori a settimana, in cambio di una fornitura di carbone, che però non arrivò mai. Oggi, a sessant'anni da quella tragedia, è venuto il momento di stabilire un rigoroso bilancio storiografico, di diffondere le testimonianze più dirette e toccanti, di rivisitarne le drammatiche immagini e di ripristinare una memoria collettiva all'altezza di quella dolorosa tragedia, in cui si riscoprono momenti e contesti che per molti aspetti assomigliano alle tristi pagine attuali di cronaca delle migrazioni.

**Breve storia dell'emigrazione italiana in Svizzera** Toni Ricciardi. 2018-02-14T00:00:00+01:00 «Nel Mondiale giocato in Brasile nel 2014, la Svizzera è stata la nazionale più cosmopolita. Paradossalmente, la nazionale elvetica è diventata la più internazionale del mondo, proprio qualche mese dopo il 9 febbraio del 2014. Quando, per una manciata di voti, passò, per la prima volta nella sua lunga e travagliata storia di impulsi anti-stranieri, l'iniziativa contro l'immigrazione di massa che fece tremare le cancellerie di mezza Europa e funse da modello per i fautori della Brexit». In fatto di migrazione, la Svizzera rappresenta un caso emblematico e, insieme, un modello ricco di paradossi. Nel 2014, quando per una manciata di voti passò l'iniziativa contro l'immigrazione di massa, la Svizzera espresse anche la nazionale più cosmopolita del Mondiale in Brasile. È il paese europeo che nel secolo scorso ha conosciuto il tasso d'immigrazione più alto del continente, assorbendo quasi la metà dell'emigrazione italiana del secondo dopoguerra. In settant'anni ha raddoppiato la sua popolazione, passando da quattro milioni agli oltre otto odierni, e la migrazione è al centro del dibattito da sempre. Nel 1948, per la prima volta nella sua storia, la Svizzera firmò un accordo di reclutamento di manodopera straniera, che divenne un modello per i successivi e cambiò per sempre la sua storia e quella del suo principale fornitore di donne e uomini, l'Italia. Paese dal quale, a partire dai trafori dell'Ottocento e per un secolo, sono giunti oltre cinque milioni di persone, la metà solo nel secondo dopoguerra. Ancora oggi, quella in Svizzera è la terza comunità italiana nel mondo. Concepita come temporanea, dopo qualche decennio divenne stanziale e rappresentò il carburante per la crescita e l'espansione dell'economia elvetica. Nessun paese europeo registrò performance così favorevoli e allo stesso tempo un così alto numero di morti bianche, che raggiunsero l'apice con la tragedia di Mattmark. Assopitosi il decennio delle tensioni xenofobe, all'inizio degli anni ottanta venne accantonata una possibile soluzione per migliorare le condizioni di chi contribuiva al progresso e al benessere del paese. Sono ormai lontani gli anni delle baracche, del «non si fitta agli italiani» o dei trentamila bambini clandestini. A tutt'oggi, la Svizzera è l'unico paese al mondo, oltre all'Italia, in cui l'italiano è lingua ufficiale. E l'italianità, pur tra alti e bassi, è riconosciuta, ricercata, apprezzata. Da un decennio si registra la ripresa di una nuova mobilità italiana: alle professioni specializzate si è unito il crescente numero di frontalieri e di chi è alla ricerca di un lavoro qualsiasi. Il rischio è che si ripropongano le questioni di un passato ricco di suggestioni e contraddizioni, che fanno della migrazione italiana in Svizzera un unicum senza precedenti.

**Migrant Labour in Europe, 1600-1900** Jan Lucassen. 2024-04-15 Migrant Labour in Europe (1987) examines the movement of workers from less prosperous parts of Europe to areas with demand for their services. The author identifies seven major systems of migrant labour: the North Sea System (mainly Westphalian workers heading for the German and Dutch North Sea Coast and Walloon/French workers bound for the Belgian and Zeeland coasts); the area between London and the Humber; the Paris Basin; Provence, Languedoc and Catalonia; Castile; Piedmont; and central Italy with Corsica.
