The 1728 Musin Rebellion Andrew David Jackson.2016-01-31 The 1728 Musin Rebellion: Politics and Plotting in Eighteenth-Century Korea provides the first comprehensive account in English of the Musin Rebellion, an attempt to overthrow King Yǒngjo (1694–1776; r. 1724–1776), and the largest rebellion of eighteenth-century Korea.
