**Asia and China in the Global Era** Adrian J. Bailey,Ricardo K. S. Mak.2021-01-18 China's strong economic growth occurring alongside modernization across the great majority of Asian societies has created what many see as a transnational space through and by which not only economic, social and cultural resources, but also threats and crises flow over traditional political boundaries. **Constructing a System of Irregularities** Chee Lay Tan.2015-11-25 This book investigates the poetics of three of the most internationally renowned contemporary Chinese poets – Bei Dao, Yang Lian and Duoduo – who were all exiled from China after the 1989 Tiananmen student movement. Their poetry was later to be labelled ‘Misty poetry’ (Menglongshi). Emphasising polyvalent imagery and irregular syntax, Misty poetry engenders a multiplicity of meanings, often leading to interpretational indeterminacy. This book examines three aspects of the ‘Mistiness’ of the poets’ oeuvre: the socio-historic background where Misty poets live and write; imagery; and linguistic elements. After first identifying the roots of Mistiness, this book identifies imagistic and linguistic clues in order to construct a hermeneutical system that examines the irregularities of the Misty poetics and appreciates the polysemy of the poets’ works. Stylometry is used to analyse image frequency and its significance in a stylistic manner, and a semiotic approach is then systematically applied to analyse the poets’ highly irregular images, syntax and the different effects of their poems’ obscurity. Through these approaches that unveil the poems’ evocativeness, the irregularity of the poetry’s Mistiness is established as its most powerful linguistic and imagistic aspect. The book then places the three poets’ different misty characteristics into contrast: Bei Dao’s twisted imagery and elliptical syntax, Yang’s imagery in a classically-inspired syntax, and Duoduo’s integration of images into a rhythmic syntax. While the poets’ progressions from pre- to post-exile poetics suggest the potential of a non-nationally specific, or borderless poetics, their seemingly irregular poetic Mistiness is the most powerful trait of Misty poetry for evoking its system of multifaceted significations and alternative aesthetics.

*THE LYRICAL YU DAFU* YU DAFU.2021-01-26 About the Book: Without looking into the metrical compositions of Lu Xun, Yu Dafu, and many of their iconoclast May Fourth contemporaries, a student of modern Chinese literature will never have a full grasp of the classical tradition in which they were fostered. It was a magical world of characters and wordplay as described by Cyril Birch as, “The written character was a most powerful agent. A world in a syllable, it held over the centuries its own semantic history within its own form, aesthetically satisfying and endlessly durable in its independence of phonological change.” This translation anthology renders 300 lyrical poems by Yu Dafu, about half of his extant oeuvre. They are representative of the poet’s literary merit and highly biographical of his life, covering his birth, family, education, social hangouts, love, traveling, and marriages. Predominately juejiu (quatrains) and lushi (full-length regulated verse), those lyrical poems are thought to be the finest among the writings of modern Chinese classical poetry. This translation tries to retain a Chinese rhythmic structure as much as possible, rhyming where the source poem rhymes. The reader may feel, at first, deprived of the comfort of English poetics. Yet, once he overcomes this initial uneasiness, he will soon comprehend the Chinese tonal pattern, which becomes more pleasing with reading as the rhyming grows more frequent and consistent.

*Breeze of a Spring Evening and Other Stories* Yu Dafu.2017-08-09 Yu Dafu (1896 - 1945) was an eminent Chinese short story writer, novelist and poet of the May Fourth period. Born in Fuyang, Zhejiang province, Yu Dafu grew up in the late-Qing and early Republican era, a time of turmoil in which China faced foreign aggression, social upheaval and economic decline. Like many young Chinese of his generation, Yu received his education in Japan, a country whose ability to industrialize and build a strong military was viewed as a model to emulate. In 1921, while he still lived in Japan, Yu Dafu and other Chinese writers founded the Creation Society, which promoted vernacular and modern literature. Yu's first major literary success was *Sinking*, a volume of stories that explored the weakness, isolation and disorientation of the modern psyche. *Sinking* had a profound impact on the Chinese intelligentsia of the time not only because of its innovative language and the use of Japanese and Western themes, but also because it depicted the pain and distress of the individual in the context of China's sense of humiliation and crisis. During the 1920s Yu Dafu continued to write short stories and novels, mostly autobiographical. In 1928 he left the Creation Society and became the co-editor of a literary magazine alongside Lu Xun. He was a founding member of the influential League of Left-wing Writers. However, Yu did not share the opinion of many leftist authors that

literature should be an instrument of political activism. He soon quit the League and joined Lin Yutang and Zhou Zuoren, who advocated a non-political, individualistic type of literature. Later in his life Yu Dafu's focus shifted from fiction to essays and poems in the traditional style. When Japan invaded China in 1937, Yu Dafu was working as a government official in Fujian province. During the war he moved to Singapore, where he worked as a newspaper editor. When the city fell to the Japanese in 1942, he fled to Sumatra. In 1945 Japanese police discovered his identity and arrested him. He was executed shortly after Japan's surrender.

Lu Xun, formerly also romanized Lu Hsun, was the pen name of Zhou Shuren (25 September 1881 - 19 October 1936), a leading figure of modern Chinese literature. Writing in Vernacular Chinese as well as Classical Chinese, Lu Xun was a short story writer, editor, translator, literary critic, essayist, and poet. In the 1930s he became the titular head of the League of Left-Wing Writers in Shanghai.

*The Chinese May Fourth Generation and the Irish Literary Revival: Writers and Fighters* Simone O'Malley-Sutton.2023-11-07 This book examines how the early twentieth-century Irish Renaissance (Irish Literary Revival) inspired the Chinese Renaissance (the May Fourth generation) of writers to make agentic choices and translingual exchanges. It sheds a new light on "May Fourth" and on the Irish Renaissance by establishing that the Irish Literary Revival (1900-1922) provided an alternative decolonizing model of resistance for the Chinese Renaissance to that provided by the western imperial center. The book also argues that Chinese May Fourth intellectuals translated Irish Revivalist plays by W. B. Yeats, Lady Gregory, Seán O'Casey and Synge and that Chinese peasants performed these plays throughout China during the 1920s and 1930s as a form of anti-imperial resistance. Yet this literary exchange was not simply going one way, since Yeats, Lady Gregory, Synge and O'Casey were also influenced by Chinese developments in literature and politics. Therefore this was a reciprocal encounter based on the circulation of Anti-colonial ideals and mutual transformation.

*China's May Fourth Movement* Sabaree Mitra.2023-02-28 This book looks at China's May Fourth Movement and how it has been contextualised in modern Chinese history. Tracing the roots of the movement and of modern Chinese literary and intellectual traditions, the book analyses how the movement transformed ideas, culture, and social practices in the country.
