Romanticism, Philosophy, and Literature Michael N. Forster, Lina Steiner. 2020-05-26 This book offers a broad re-evaluation of the key ideas developed by the German Romantics concerning philosophy and literature. It focuses not only on their own work, but also on that of their fellow travelers (such as Hölderlin) and their contemporary opponents (such as Hegel), as well as on various reactions to and transpositions of their ideas in later authors, including Coleridge, Byron, Kierkegaard, Nietzsche, and Dostoevsky.

Heinrich Von Kleist Jeffrey L. High, Rebecca Stewart, Elaine Chen. 2022 Volume of new essays investigating Kleist's influences and sources both literary and philosophical, their role as paradigms, and the ways in which he responded to and often shattered them. Heinrich von Kleist (1777-1811) was a rebel who upset canonization by employing his predecessors and contemporaries as what Steven Howe calls inspirational foils. It was precisely a keen awareness of literary and philosophical traditions that allowed Kleist to shatter prevailing paradigms. Though little is known about what specifically Kleist read, the frequent allusions in his enduringly modern oeuvre indicate fruitful dialogues with both canonical and marginal works of European literature, spanning antiquity (The Old Testament, Sophocles), the Early Modern Period (Shakespeare, De Zayas), the late Enlightenment (Wieland, Goethe, Schiller), and the first eleven years of the nineteenth century (Mereau, Brentano, Collin). Kleist's works also evidence encounters with his philosophical precursors and contemporaries, including the ancient Greeks (Aristotle) and representatives of all phases of

Enlightenment thought (Montesquieu, Rousseau, Ferguson, Spalding, Fichte, Kant, Hegel), economic theories (Smith, Kraus), and developments in anthropology, sociology, and law. Kolleghefte, Kollegnachschriften und Protokolle Jörn Bohr.2019-06-04 Dieser Band formuliert - über den Kontext philosophischer Editionen hinaus - Probleme und Forschungsfragen, die sich in der Edition von Manuskripten zu Vorlesungen, von Nachschriften sowie von Seminarprotokollen ergeben. Der Fokus liegt auf methodischen Lösungsansätzen, die exemplarisch an Editionsprojekten von Texten des 18. bis 20.

Jahrhunderts vorgeführt werden. Damit bildet der Band ein Kompendium, von dem weitere editorische Forschung ausgehen kann. Frank Grunert und Holger Glinka eröffnen den Band, indem sie am Beispiel der Edition einer Nachschrift der Grotius-Vorlesung von Christian Wolff zeigen, dass professionell hergestellte Nachschriften auf eine besondere wissenssoziologische Situation hinweisen: Mit der zunehmenden Emanzipation der Vorlesungen von kanonischen Lehrbüchern hat die Vorlesung selbst Lehrbuchcharakter entwickelt, der den Zugzwang ihrer Hörer noch verstärkt, sich des von Professoren gesprochenen Wortes schriftlich zu vergewissern. Der Handel mit Nachschriften hat hier seinen Grund wie in der Überlieferung besonders elaborierter Manuskripte in den Nachlässen adeliger und vermögender Häuser. Werner Stark stellt die problematische Funktion von Nachschriften als vermeintlicher Stütze für weitgehend ungeschriebene Werke am Beispiel von Kants *Physischer Geographie* in der Ausgabe Rink heraus und teilt damit spezifische Erfahrungen mit den älteren Editionen von Nachschriften Kantischer Vorlesungen in Königsberg mit. Holden Kelm rekonstruiert im historischen Vergleich, wie unterschiedliche Editionsstandards und v. a. Absichten ihren Autor gerade in der Rekonstruktion seiner Lehre jeweils neu konstituieren, sodass ein editorisch manifestes theologisches Interesse an Schleiermacher zunehmend von einem philosophischen abgelöst wird. Annette Sell spürt anhand der Edition der Vorlesungsnachschriften zu Hegels *Logik* der Frage nach Hegels möglicherweise eigenen Überlieferungsabsichten seines in seiner Bewegung vorgetragenen Werkes nach. Johannes Korngiebel nimmt eine Nachschrift zu Friedrich Schlegels Jenaer Vorlesung zur *Transcendentalphilosophie* von 1800/01 zum Anlass, die Leistungsfähigkeit einer textkritischen Auswertung von Vorlesungsnachschriften für die Edition exemplarisch darzustellen. Christoph Binkelmann teilt aus der Werkstatt Schellings die editorischen Herausforderungen mit, die dessen

Vorlesungen über Philosophie der Kunst bedeuten. Daniel Elon beleuchtet Schopenhauers Versuche als Dozent, wie sie sich in den Manuskripten zu dessen Vorlesung von 1820 darstellen. Francisco Arenas-Dolz nimmt Nietzsche als Universitätslehrer ernst und vertieft anhand der Edition der Vorlesung „Einleitung in das Studium der klassischen Philologie“ die Reflexionen über das Verhältnis von Vorlesungen und den sie begleitenden Textarten. Windelbands vor wenigen Jahren in Sendai (Japan) wiederaufgefundene Manuskripte zur Vorbereitung von Lehrveranstaltungen und Publikationsvorhaben sind Gegenstand von Jörn Bohrs Beitrag. Andrea Leubin und Monika Philippi gewähren einen Einblick in die Edition von Vortragsnachschriften innerhalb der Rudolf Steiner Gesamtausgabe. Max Webers Manuskripte für Vorlesungen dienen Sophia Krebs und Ulrich Rummel als Fallbeispiel für das Ermitteln und Belegen von Krypto-Zitaten und Paraphrasen, einem Hauptgegenstand editorischen Kommentierens. Mit Thomas Kessels Beitrag zu Nicolai Hartmanns Circelprotokollen wird das 20. Jahrhundert in den Blick genommen, als in den Seminaren und Kolloquien die Form des Protokolls Einzug hielt. Dirk Braunstein liefert eingehende Reflexionen über den möglichen Sinn der Begriffe ‚Autorschaft‘ und ‚Authentizität‘ in der Editionspraxis solcher Seminarprotokolle. – Beigefügt ist eine Bibliographie zum Thema Edition von Kollegheften, Kollegnachschriften und Protokollen.

Ding und Bild in der europäischen Romantik Jakob Christoph Heller, Erik Martin, Sebastian Schönbeck. 2020-12-07 Ding und Bild sind Schlüsselbegriffe der romantischen Poetik und Philosophie. Das hat auch die jüngste kultur- und literaturwissenschaftliche Romantikforschung erkannt. Allerdings untersucht sie Dinglichkeit und Bildlichkeit bislang als getrennte Problemfelder: Bildlichkeit scheint vorwiegend als Synonym für die Kraft der Imagination in der Frühphase der Romantik von Bedeutung zu sein, während Dinglichkeit als Indikator für das Verhältnis zum Realismus in der Spätphase der Romantik

relevant ist. Ein Blick in die Texte der Romantik zeigt allerdings, dass beide Schlüsselbegriffe unabhängig von ihrer Phasenzuordnung zusammenhängen und dass die Übergänge von Dingen und Bildern häufig fließend gestaltet sind. Der Band untersucht das produktive Spannungsverhältnis dieser beiden Konzepte und ihre Vermischungen vor dem Hintergrund der historischen und systematischen Zusammenhänge der europäischen Romantik. Er versammelt Beiträge von Literatur-, Kultur- und Kunstwissenschaftler*innen und nimmt Bezüge zu anderen Wissensfeldern wie der Ökonomie, Philosophie, Physik oder Religion in den Blick.

The Philology of Life Kevin McLaughlin. 2023-01-17 The Philology of Life retraces the outlines of the philological project developed by Walter Benjamin in his early essays on Hölderlin, the Romantics, and Goethe. This philological program, McLaughlin shows, provides the methodological key to Benjamin's work as a whole. According to Benjamin, German literary history in the period roughly following the first World War was part of a wider "crisis of historical experience"—a life crisis to which Lebensphilosophie (philosophy of life) had instructively but insufficiently responded. Benjamin's literary critical struggle during these years consisted in developing a philology of literary historical experience and of life that is rooted in an encounter with a written image. The fundamental importance of this "philological" method in Benjamin's work seems not to have been recognized by his contemporary readers, including Theodor Adorno who considered the approach to be lacking in dialectical rigor. This facet of Benjamin's work was also elided in the postwar publications of his writings, both in German and English. In recent decades, the publication of a wider range of Benjamin's writings has made it possible to retrace the outlines of a distinctive philological project that starts to develop in his early literary criticism and that extends into the late studies of Baudelaire and Paris. By bringing this innovative method to light

this study proposes “the philology of life” as the key to the critical program of one of the most influential intellectual figures in the humanities.

Die Freiheit des Subjekts bei Schleiermacher Katharina Gutekunst.2019-02-19 Wie denkt Friedrich Schleiermacher, mit dem man zuerst die Bestimmung von Frömmigkeit als Gefühl der schlechthinnigen Abhängigkeit verbindet, die Freiheit des Subjekts? Um diese Frage zu beantworten, untersucht Katharina Gutekunst die relevanten Werke aus allen Schaffensperioden Schleiermachers: die Jugendschriften, die Monologen (und die Reden), die Erwählungsschrift, die Glaubenslehre und die Vorlesungen zu Psychologie, Philosophischer Ethik und Dialektik. Die Rekonstruktion und Diskussion der Freiheitstheorie Schleiermachers erfolgt dabei im Horizont der aktuellen Debatte um die Willensfreiheit in der analytischen Philosophie. So wird deutlich, dass Schleiermacher eine kompatibilistische Theorie vertritt, die auch die ontologischen und metaphysischen Begründungszusammenhänge von Freiheit reflektiert.

Assembly and its Other in German Romantic Literature and Thought Robert E. Mottram, Christopher R. Clason.2022-10-15 This collection of essays turns on a shift in Romantic studies from viewing wholeness as an absolute value to critiquing it as a limiting construction. Wholeness and its concomitant sense of harmony, rather than a natural given, is a construct that was assembled and disassembled, theorized and criticized, by diverse authors and artists in a wide variety of disciplines and socio-historical contexts, and instrumentalized for diverse purposes. The plurality of these constructions – that Goethe’s Urpflanze, for example, is not synonymous with Friedrich Schlegel’s universal progressive poetry – is but one manifestation of how “assembly” strives but fails to be absolute. The “other” of assembly referenced in the title suggests two divergent but inseparable tendencies: firstly, how a construction can take on the appearance of a natural given; and secondly, how assemblages of

wholeness harbor within themselves their own principle of disarticulation. These two tendencies underlie the “inexhaustible” character of Romantic “gatherings”. As a construction passes itself off as nature, the natural fails to account for itself as a whole. The scope of this volume encompasses the establishment, mapping, and interrogation of assembly and its other in German Romanticism through interdisciplinary studies on literature, aesthetics, philosophy, drama, music, synaesthesia, mathematics, science, and exploration. Forms and Functions of Endings in Narrative Digital Games

Michelle Herte. 2020-09-16 This book looks closely at the endings of narrative digital games, examining their ways of concluding the processes of both storytelling and play in order to gain insight into what endings are and how we identify them in different media. While narrative digital games share many representational strategies for signalling their upcoming end with more traditional narrative media – such as novels or movies – they also show many forms of endings that often radically differ from our conventional understanding of conclusion and closure. From vast game worlds that remain open for play after a story’s finale, to multiple endings that are often hailed as a means for players to create their own stories, to the potentially tragic endings of failure and game over, digital games question the traditional singularity and finality of endings. Using a broad range of examples, this book delves deeply into these and other forms and their functions, both to reveal the closural specificities of the ludonarrative hybrid that digital games are, as well as to find the core elements that characterise endings in any medium. August Wilhelm Schlegel und die Episteme der Geschichte Franz

Lebsanft.2021-10-11 Kurz vor Beginn seiner im Wintersemester 1818/1819 aufgenommenen, jahrzehntelangen Tätigkeit an der neugegründeten Universität Bonn publizierte August Wilhelm Schlegel noch in Paris die »Observations sur la langue et la littérature provençales«. Die »Observations« werden in diesem Buch neu entdeckt als die brillante Skizze einer philologisch, linguistisch und literarisch begründeten historisch-

vergleichenden Provenzalistik und Romanistik. Schlegel nahm darin auch die germanischen Sprachen in den Blick, weil sie nach seiner Auffassung eine entscheidende Rolle für die Entstehung des Französischen spielen. Die Beiträgerinnen und Beiträger des Bandes eröffnen neue sprach- und literaturwissenschaftliche Zugänge zu den zahlreichen Facetten der »Observations«, aber auch über dieses Werk hinaus zu Schlegels Übersetzungen aus den romanischen Literaturen und deren Rezeption in der modernen Literatur. Shortly before the winter semester 1818/1819, when he would begin his decades-long professional career at the newly founded Rhenish Friedrich Wilhelm University of Bonn, August Wilhelm Schlegel published his *Observations sur la langue et la littérature provençales* while still living in Paris. Originally intended as a review of the first volumes of Raynouard's *Choix des poésies originales des troubadours*, the *Observations* quickly became known as nothing less than an original and momentous outline of a philologically, linguistically, and literarily founded historical-comparative concept of Provençal and Romance studies. Besides, Schlegel also considered Germanic languages since these, according to him, played a decisive role in the emergence of at least the French language. The contributors to this volume open up new approaches to the study of Schlegel's *Observations*. On the one hand, these concern both the numerous linguistic and literary aspects of the *Observations*; on the other hand, they also treat Schlegel's translations from Romance literatures as well as their reception in modern literature.

Lucinde. Ein Roman. Race, Nation, History Oded Y. Steinberg. 2019-08-02 In *Race, Nation, History*, Oded Y. Steinberg examines the way a series of nineteenth-century scholars in England and Germany first constructed and then questioned the periodization of history into ancient, medieval, and modern eras, shaping the way we continue to think about the past and present of Western civilization at a fundamental level. Steinberg explores this topic by tracing the deep connections between the idea of epochal periodization and concepts of race and nation that were prevalent at the time—especially the role that Germanic or Teutonic tribes were assumed to play in the unfolding of Western history. Steinberg shows how English scholars such as Thomas Arnold, Williams Stubbs, and John Richard Green; and German scholars such as Christian Karl Josias von Bunsen, Max Müller, and Reinhold Pauli built on the notion of a shared Teutonic kinship to establish a correlation between the division of time and the ascent or descent of races or nations. For example, although they viewed the Germanic tribes' conquest of the Roman Empire in A.D. 476 as a formative event that symbolized the transformation from antiquity to the Middle Ages, they did so by highlighting the injection of a new and dominant ethnoracial character into the decaying empire. But they also rejected the idea that the fifth century A.D. was the most decisive era in historical periodization, advocating instead for a historical continuity that emphasized the significance of the Germanic tribes' influence on the making of the nations of modern Europe. Concluding with character studies of E. A. Freeman, James Bryce, and J. B. Bury, Steinberg

demonstrates the ways in which the innovative schemes devised by this community of Victorian historians for the division of historical time relied on the cornerstone of race.

Worlding a Peripheral Literature Marko Juvan.2019-10-12 Bringing together the analyses of the literary world-system, translation studies, and the research of European cultural nationalism, this book contests the view that texts can be attributed global importance irrespective of their origin, language, and position in the international book market. Focusing on Slovenian literature, almost unknown to world literature studies, this book addresses world literature's canonical function in the nineteenth-century process of establishing European letters as national literatures. Aware of their dependence on imperial powers, (semi)peripheral national movements sought international recognition through, among other things, the newly invented figure of the national poet. Writers central to dependent national communities were canonized to represent their respective cultures to the norm-giving Other - the emerging world literary canon and its aesthetic ideology. Hence, national literatures asserted their linguo-cultural individuality through the process of worlding; that is, by their positioning in the international literary world informed by the supposed universality of the aesthetic.

The journal promotes innovative research across disciplinary borders. It aims to advance new historical discoveries, forward-looking theoretical insights and cutting-edge methodological approaches. The articles range over the full variety of cultural practices, including the written word, visual arts, history, philosophy, religion, and theatre during the romantic period (c. 1780-1840). But contributions to the discussion of pre- or post-romantic representations are also welcome. Since the romantic era was characterized by an emphasis on the vernacular, the title of the journal has been chosen to reflect the Germanic root of the word.

But the journal is interested in all European romanticisms - and not least the connections and disconnections between them - hence, the use of the plural in the subtitle. *Romantik* is a peer-reviewed journal supported by the Nordic Board for Periodicals in the Humanities and Social Sciences (NOP-HS).

Die Geschichtlichkeit des Briefs Norman Kasper, Jana Kittelmann, Jochen Strobel, Robert Vellusig. 2021-08-23 Wie hat sich der Brief als Kommunikationsform in den letzten 3.000 Jahren entwickelt? Was hat sich gewandelt? Welche Strukturelemente blieben unverändert? Als Text, als Objekt und als kommunikatives Ereignis lebt der Brief in seiner Wiedererkennbarkeit von Invarianzen, die die Reproduzierbarkeit eines Musters auch unter sich wandelnden kulturellen Bedingungen zu garantieren scheinen. Es ist diese zwischen Formalisierung und Offenheit changierende Textualität, die zum einen das Interesse disziplinär konturierter Fragehorizonte auf sich zieht, die zum anderen aber ohne interdisziplinären Austausch wohl kaum in ihrer Spannbreite ausgemessen werden kann. Defiguration der Schrift Caroline Schubert. 2021-02-08 Die Defiguration der Schrift - der Tintenlecks, der Makulaturfetzen, der Schreibfehler - bricht mit der Schrift als vom gestaltlosen Hintergrund abgehobener, distinkter Zeichenfigur. Der drohende oder eingetretene Verlust der schriftlichen Repräsentation lässt dabei Visualität und Stofflichkeit der Schrift hervortreten. Die Studie untersucht dieses bei den zwei Autoren der europäischen Romantik E.T.A. Hoffmann und Nikolaj Gogol' gehäuft auftretende, doch bisher kaum wissenschaftlich beachtete literarische Motiv und materielle Phänomen in publizierten Texten, Handschriften und Zeichnungen. Dabei werden zunächst zentrale Konflikte der (früh-)romantischen Schriftreflexion in ihrem mediengeschichtlichen Kontext herausgearbeitet und

Schelling-Studien Lore Hühn, Philipp Höfele, Philipp Schwab, Paul Ziche. 2022-07-08 Die internationale Zeitschrift Schelling-Studien bietet ein Forum für wissenschaftliche Arbeiten zur Philosophie Schellings und für übergreifende Fragestellungen des Idealismus und seiner Wirkungsgeschichte. ordentliche Bühnenführung. Bekannte Schauspieltalente wie Wilhelmine Berger oder Heinrich Marr gingen bei ihm in die Schule. 1823 brachte er Heines »Almator«, 1829 Goethes »Faust« zur Uraufführung. Doch während Klingemanns Name in der Theatergeschichte eine feste Größe ist, wird er in der Literaturgeschichte nur am Rande erwähnt - als Verfasser epigonaler Dramen und Autor eines genialen Romans: »Nachtwachen von Bonaventura«. Manuel Zink betrachtet nun erstmals das Gesamtwerk des geschäftigen Bühnenleiters und verortet es funktional in den historischen Kontext um 1800. Ausgehend von Klingemanns theatertheoretischen Essays schlägt das Buch einen Bogen von den frühen experimentellen Texten romantischer Prägung bis zu den späten Dramen in der Nachfolge Schillers mit dem Ziel, die in ihnen dargestellten Kunstrezeptionen zu befragen. Indem Klingemann in seinen praxisbezogenen Theaterstücken Situationen inszeniert, die ebenso gut im Museum hätten stattfinden können, profiliert er den Akt Musealisierung als wirkungsästhetisches Prinzip und antizipiert in dieser Weise Aspekte des modernen Theaters. Ernst August Friedrich Klingemann (1777-1831) war Dramatiker, Erzähler, Essayist und Theaterleiter in Braunschweig. Ihm ist die erste öffentliche Aufführung von Goethes »Faust« 1829 zu verdanken.

Über Wissenschaft reden Claude Haas, Daniel

Weidner.2020-02-10 Um 1800 verstärkt sich das

Problembewusstsein für eine der wissenschaftlichen Reflexion adäquate Darstellung, da sich die Überzeugung durchsetzt, die Sprache sei nicht nur ein Werkzeug, sondern vielmehr ein »bildendes Organ des Gedankens« (Wilhelm v. Derartigen Spannungen spürt der Band im Kontext vornehmlich des Niedergangs (wie Fortlebens) der Rhetorik und der Neubegründung der Universität nach.

Holderlin's Philosophy of Nature Tobias Rochelle

Die Autorin zeigt, dass *Le Brésil littéraire* im Zeichen der ideologischen Ansprüche einer transnationalen Elite entstand, die auf dynastischen Bündnissen basierte: Die (Literatur-)Geschichtsschreibung wird hier als Werkzeug eingesetzt, um eine Vergangenheit zu konstruieren und die Gegenwart zu steuern. Ihre Analyse der diskursiven Verkehrung der tatsächlichen Verhältnisse enthüllt, wie diese dazu dienen können, die eigene Herrschaftsposition zu begründen und zu festigen.
