Philippe Grandrieux Greg Hainge.2017-02-23 Philippe Grandrieux is one of cinema's only living true radicals and feted as one of the most innovative and important film makers of his generation. Rumour and Radiation Paul Hegarty.2014-12-18 This is a book about video art, and about sound art. The Oxford Handbook of Sound and Image in Western Art Yael Kaduri. 2016-07-14 The Oxford Handbook of Sound and Image in Western Art examines, under one umbrella, different kinds of analogies, mutual influences, integrations and collaborations of audio and visual in different art forms.
