Many different cultures have made their way to Cuba-French, Creole, African, Spanish, British and many others. Religions have clashed, customs have been battled over but Cuba today is a fascinating blend of dozens of races, religions, customs, creeds and beliefs. Cuba has been under the thumb of many governments, and it boasts a long and proud history of resistance.
